Education and Experience

Beckie McLeod earned her Master of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine degree from the Colorado School of Traditional Chinese Medicine in August of 2008. This three year program consists of 2,850 hours of education, including 795 hours of clinical practice. Beckie was certified as a Diplomate in Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM) in December of 2008. This includes certification in Clean Needle Technique and Chinese Herbology.

Beckie's training includes adjunctive therapies such as moxibustion, tui na, acupressure, cupping, auriculotherapy, electro acupuncture, use and proper prescription of herbs, dietary and lifestyle recommendations and all other adjunctive therapies defined by Traditional Oriental Medicine concepts. She is a registered acupuncturist in Colorado. None of these licenses, certifications, or registrations has ever been suspended or revoked.

Health Compliance and Regulation

Beckie McLeod complies with the rules and regulations promulgated by the Colorado Department of Health, including the proper cleaning and sterilization of needles and the sanitation of acupuncture offices. Only single-use, disposable, factory-sterilized needles are utilized. The patient is entitled to receive information about the methods of therapy, the techniques used, and the duration of therapy, if known.
